

A Guide to Repairing Glazed Titanium-Steel Products

Bette products are manufactured from glazed titanium-steel. The enamelling process involves coating the product with a glass based mixture (enamel). The product then goes into a very high temperature kiln to bond the enamel coating to the titanium-steel surface. Bette products boast the best and most attractive enamel surface which is manufactured utilising ultra-modern methods.

Whilst rare, when an item is dropped into the bath or the bath comes into contact with a hard surface on the underside, impact damage can occur, and this can appear as chips in the enamel surface.

In most cases it is possible to repair this damage, using various methods which are described below, along with a list of useful contacts:

Re-enamelling

Some companies offer a re-enamelling service. This involves the bath being re-coated with enamel. In order to carry out this process, the bath must be removed, as baking at high temperatures is required to re-create an enamelled surface. Any company that is offering to re-enamel a bath in situ should be avoided, as it is impossible to re-enamel without using the high heat process.

Resurfacing

Resurfacing can be carried out on a fitted product. This is not the same as re-enamelling, but instead involves coating the whole surface with paint like substance. This is not as durable as enamel, but provides a cheaper and easier option of improving the entire surface of the product.

<u>Repair</u>

Many of the companies that offer re-surfacing will also offer a chip repair surface. The area of damage is treated and the same paint like substance used for product resurfacing is applied to the damaged area. Again, this is not the same as enamelling but provides a cosmetically appealing solution to a chipped or damaged product.

DIY Repair

Several companies offer DIY repair kits. This is the same paint like substance, available in a kit, for use at home. We have only carried out testing on our own touch up paint called Remalle. While this provides an easy quick fix to the damage or chip, it is a temporary measure and we would advise seeking professional advice in the long term. Bette GmbH & Co.
