



IMPORTANT

Wear suitable eye protection when drilling. Take care when using power tools near water - the use of a residual current device (RCD) is recommended. Beware of hidden pipes or cables. Take care when drilling tiled surfaces as the drill might slip. Use a piece of masking tape to prevent the drill from wandering.

1. Measure the distance between the holes in the two brass wall fixings (Distance X).
2. Using this measurement, mark the fixing points on the wall in the desired location, ensuring they are vertically level.
3. Using an appropriate drill bit, drill both fixing holes. Remove the brass wall fixings by loosening the grub screw on the underside of the riser rail bracket.
4. Using the fixing screws and wall plugs provided, fix the brass wall fixings to the wall.
5. Reposition the riser rail onto the two brass wall fixings until flush with the wall and fix in place with both grub screws. The riser rail is now ready for use.

AFTERCARE INSTRUCTIONS

Whilst all items have a high quality, durable finish, they should nevertheless be treated with care. Surfaces should be cleaned using only a soft damp cloth and clean water. Bath cleaning products, even non-scratch ones could damage the finished surface.
