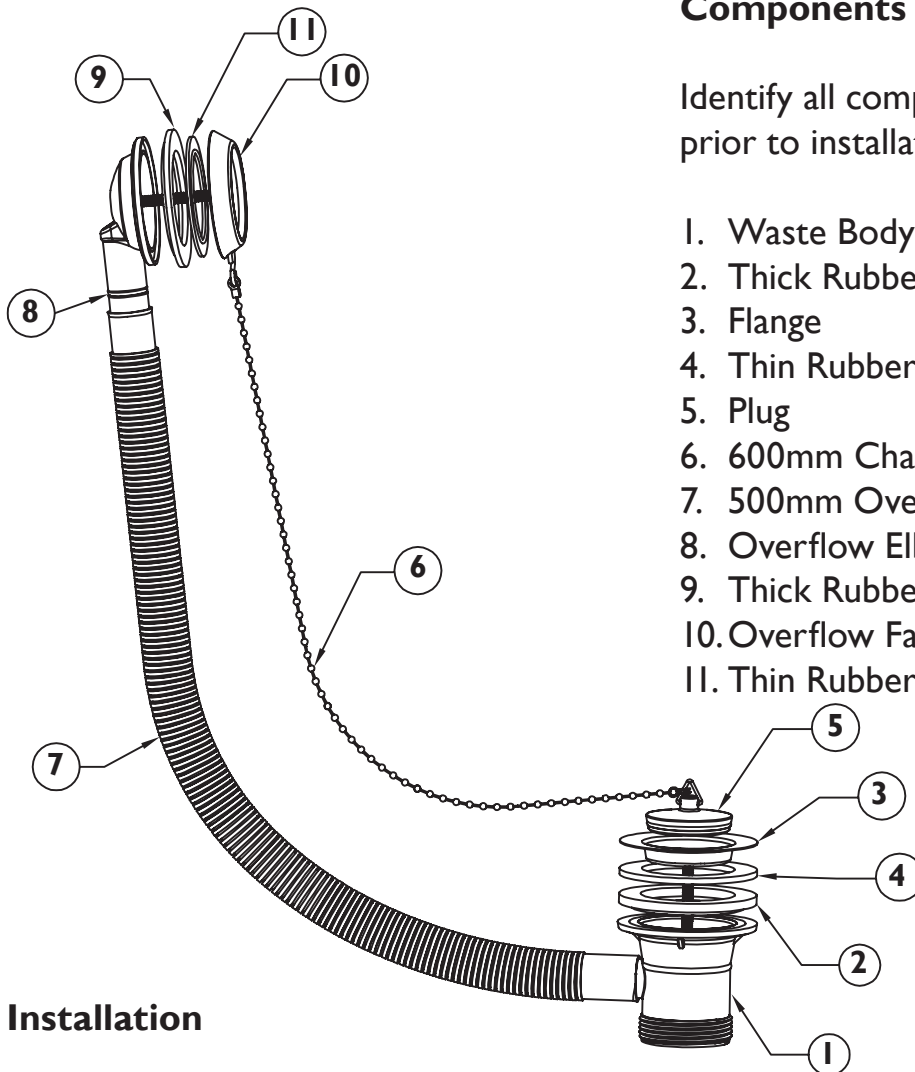

INSTALLATION

Components

Identify all components are present prior to installation:

Installation

1. Place the waste body (1) on the underside of the bath with the thick rubber washer (2) above it.
2. Secure by screwing the flange (3) down from the top of the bath, with the thin rubber washer (4) underneath. Fit the waste pipework (not supplied).
3. Place the overflow elbow (8) behind the bath with the thick rubber gasket (9) in front. Secure by screw on the overflow face (10), with the thin rubber gasket behind it (11).
4. The overflow tube (7) uses push-fit connections to secure in place. Push on to the overflow elbow (8) ensuring it goes over both O-Rings. Squeeze the other end into the waste body (1), pushing in as far as possible.
5. Check all joints and connections for leaks.



CARING FOR YOUR PRODUCT

Heritage products are made from premium materials, with hand polishing, PVD, EPD and electroplated finishes.

Your product should be regularly cleaned with warm water, a mild pH-neutral liquid soap, and polished with a soft cloth. Any residues from soap, toiletries etc. should be rinsed off straight after use.

Household bleaches and cleaners contain harsh chemicals and may damage the surface finish. Avoid using abrasive cloths, scouring pads, scrub sponges, steel wool or anything similar.

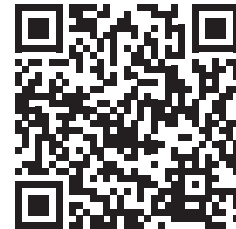
Some surfaces such as nickel and pewter may be affected by the dye found in some cloths, so it is also important to avoid leaving cloths on surfaces.
