INTRODUCTION

This guide contains all the necessary fitting instructions for your (exposed pipework) bar mixer bracket. The bracket has been designed to be surface mounted, using 15mm pipework and can be used with most bar mixers or bath shower mixers with 3/4" BSP fixings.

Please read the instructions carefully. Read through the whole of this guide before beginning installation.

The bracket installation must be carried out by a suitably competent person and in the sequence of the instruction book.

Care taken during the installation will provide trouble free operation from the bracket.

SAFETY WARNINGS

- **a.** Layout and sizing of pipework must be such that when other services are used, pressures at the mixer control inlets do not fall below the recommended minimum.
- b. DO NOT choose a position where the mixer shower could become frozen.
- c. DO NOT connect to any form of tap or fitting not recommended by the manufacturer.
- **d.** Conveniently situated service valves in each inlet supply must be fitted as an independent method of isolating the bracket should maintenance or servicing be necessary.

COMPONENTS

The bracket is supplied as shown in **fig.1** and comprises of the following:

- 1. Bracket and grub screw (2 off)
- 2. 15 mm compression fitting and olive (2 off)
- 3. Mounting plate (2 off)
- 4. Seal (2 off)
- 5. Filter (2 off)

Screws and wall plugs (not shown)

INSTALLATION

IMPORTANT: These bar mixer brackets are designed to be mounted onto a solid structure. If installing to a stud partition wall, dry lined wall or similar, it is recommended that the brackets are secured to the studs or noggins.

Decide upon the mounting position of the brackets on the tiled wall and mark the centres. Check the mounting marks are level and that the distance between them is equal to the distance between the bar mixer inlet centres (fig.2).

Drill and plug the wall. The wall plugs provided are suitable for most brick walls. Use suitable screws for the wall selected.

Secure the bracket mounting plates to the wall using the screws provided.

Note: The flat face of the mounting plate should be against the face of the wall **(fig.3)**.

Again, ensure that the distance between the centres is correct and level. The fixing hole in each mounting plate is elongated to allow some final adjustment **(fig.4)**.


Temporarily fit the brackets to the mounting plates and complete the 15mm feed pipework to the brackets.


Note: If using chrome plated copper pipework, it is recommended that the pipe be cut to length using a pipe cutter, at the end which enters the bracket.


Make sure that the end of the pipework to each bracket is deburred and is flushed through to remove any debris.

Remove each bracket from the mounting plate, slide the compression fitting and olive onto the incoming pipework. Fit the bracket to the pipework and onto the mounting plate. Secure the bracket to the mounting plate by tightening the grub screw in the base (fig.5).


Secure the pipework to the bracket (**fig.6**). Push-fit the seals into the bracket outlets (**fig.7**). Fit and secure the bar mixer to the brackets.
