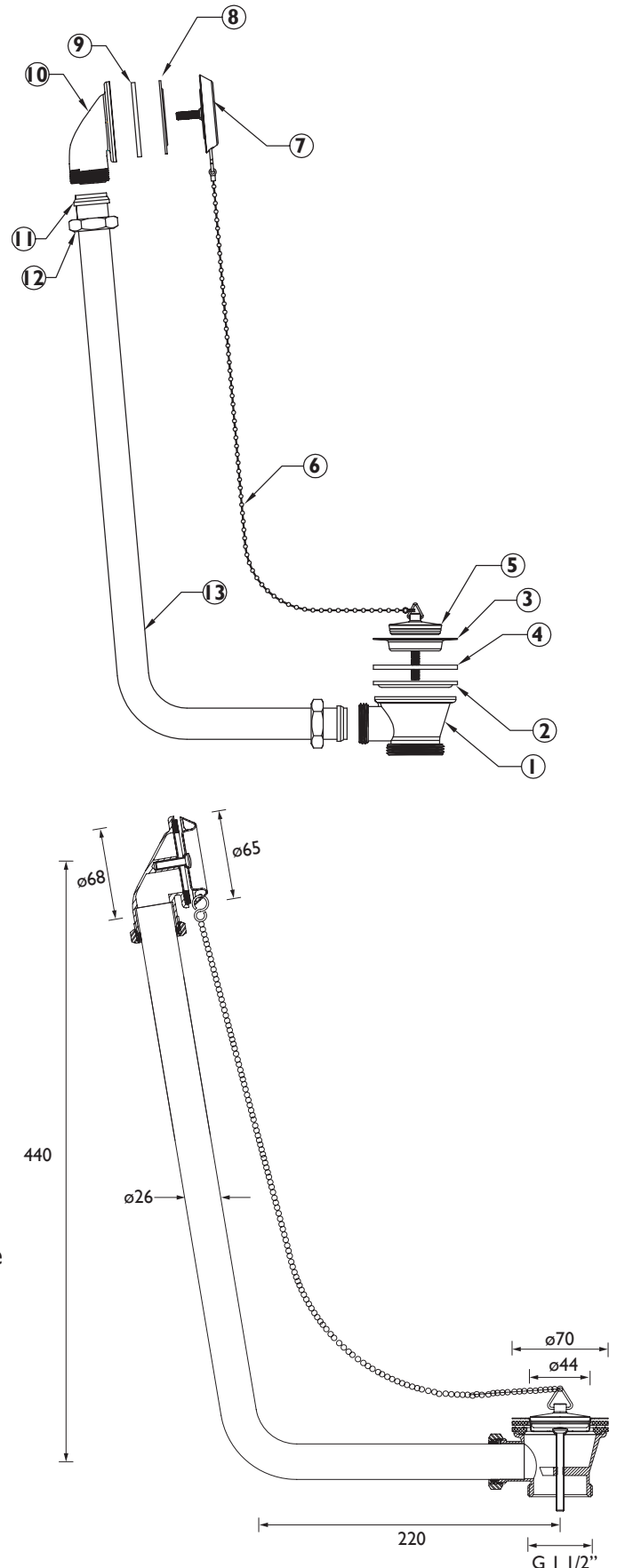
INSTALLATION

Components:

Identify all components are present prior to installation.

1. Check the dimensions of your bath to make sure that the waste assembly will fit to your bath. The L Pipe is a fixed length and should not be adjusted.
2. Place the waste body (1) underneath the bath, with the ridged rubber washer (2) above it. Secure in place by screwing down the flange (3) from the top of the bath, with the foam washer (4) underneath it.
3. Place the overflow elbow (10) behind the bath, with the rubber washer (9) in front of it. Secure in place by screwing the overflow face (7) from the inside of the bath, with the ridged overflow washer (8) behind it.
4. Insert the L Pipe (13) short end first into the waste body (1). Ensure a conical washer (11) is at the end of the tube, and connect to the waste body (1) by using a hex nut (12).
5. Repeat the process to fit the long end of the L Pipe (13) to the overflow elbow (10).
6. Check all joints and connections for leaks.



CARING FOR YOUR PRODUCT

Heritage products are made from premium materials, with hand polishing, PVD, EPD and electroplated finishes.

Your product should be regularly cleaned with warm water, a mild pH-neutral liquid soap, and polished with a soft cloth. Any residues from soap, toiletries etc. should be rinsed off straight after use.

Household bleaches and cleaners contain harsh chemicals and may damage the surface finish. Avoid using abrasive cloths, scouring pads, scrub sponges, steel wool or anything similar.

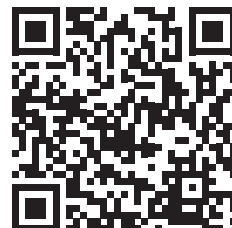
Some surfaces such as nickel and pewter may be affected by the dye found in some cloths, so it is also important to avoid leaving cloths on surfaces.
