## DESCALING



We recommend you descale your tank every 12 months. Soft scale can still build up in the tank even though you have a filter installed. Certain areas suffer from harder water than others, if you are in a very hard water area, we suggest doing this every 6-9 months. If you notice a drop in flow rate it is likely you need to descale your tank.

To descale the tank, remove the tank as per the following.

- 1 Turn off and allow the tank to cool.
- **2** Unscrew the hot and cold fittings with an adjustable spanner.
- **3** Using descaling fluid, pour the fluid into the tank via Red & Blue inlets. Follow the decaling product instructions for time and double the mixture strength.
- 4 Drain and repeat the process again.
- **5** Reconnect the tank and tighten the hot and cold connection just over hand tightness.
- **6** Run the kettle valve so that around 4 litres of water has passed and then switch the tank on and allow to heat fully. (Note: water will not exit the spout until the system is full of water).

Run an additional 2 litres off once the tank is at temperature.
