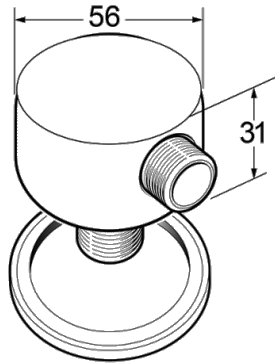
Please read all of the instructions before installation.

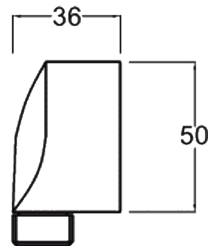
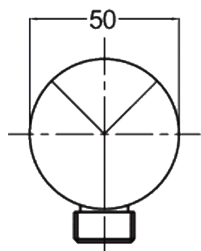
Before commencing installation of the new product, ensure that the system has been flushed to remove any debris, which could cause damage to the valves and invalidate the warranty.

Installation

- The pipe connecting the shower hose connector to the shower and the hole for the wall elbow tail to fit through should be prepared in the desired location.
- If using copper pipe, the pipe end should not be cut until the elbow has been received, so that the correct length pipe can be determined.
To do this place the elbow to the wall, with the wall trim (Not included with SPE03) (if this is to be used dependent on wall thickness) fitted between the elbow and the wall, then cut pipe to correct length, if compression fitting ensure that the pipe length allows for a minimum of 10mm pipe to be inserted into the tail.
- If copper pipes are used, these should be bracketed.
- If plastic pipes or flexi-tails are being used, then the back nut must be fitted to hold the elbow into position.
- Remove the elbow from the wall then fit trim (if applicable) (Not included in SPE03)
- Place the tail through the hole in the wall and screw on the back nut until secure, then connect a pipe nut (not supplied) with sealing method dependent on installers method of connection and tighten until water tight.
- When fully tightened, turn on water supply and check for leaks.
Connect the shower hose to the outlet.
