Installation Instructions

- 1) Carefully unscrew the existing handset from your shower hose.
- 2) Inspect the hose thread for damage/debris and clean or replace as required.
- 3) Remove and replace the filter washer in the hose connection (not supplied) if required.
- 4) Offer the handset up to the hose and screw together, ensuring the components do not cross thread, until tight.
- 5) Pointing the handset in a safe direction, turn the shower on and check for leaks.
